1. The meeting was called to order at 5:03 pm by Susie Kimble

- 4. Moved by Jennifer Kozlowski and seconded by Martha Valdez that the agenda be approved as amended. Votes: Unanimous.
- 5. Moved by Oscar Juarez and seconded by Jennifer Kozlowski that the minutes of September 13, 2018 be approved. Votes: Unanimous.
- 6. There was considerable discussion regarding the student achievement pay for 2018-19 to be paid out in SY19-20. The discussion whether or not to give incentives to teachers as a result of the PED letter grade. The discussion also included if administration would be included in the payouts. If the PED points on the report card stay within a C but do not reach 61.4, teachers and admin will receive \$750. If the points increase to 61.5 or higher, the incentive pay will be \$1,000. If the letter grade results in a B, the pay will be \$2,000. Moved by Jennifer Kozlowski and seconded by Martha Valdez that the student achievement pay be approved. Votes: Unanimous.
- 7. The Finance Committee met prior to the GC meeting. Kyle presented the 9/30/2018 reports to the finance committee and the governing council. It was noted that the remaining negative budget items were the result of a revenue BAR still awaiting PED processing on OBMS or other awards expected to come in next month. The ending bank balance for September 30<sup>th</sup> was \$1,240,917.53 with \$527,896.01 being the unrestricted cash portion of the bank balance. There were 2 BARs presented to the governing council tonight. The first was for increasing IDEA\_B budget for the second amount of our award, and the second is the initial FY19 award of Title IV Student Support for a college readiness and career coach. The Finance Committee recommends the financial report and two BARs be approved as presented. Votes: Unanimous.

- 8. The principal provided a comparison between last year and this year's attendance, student ages and grade. Number are low compared to last years. No specific reason.
