## Minutes of the GC

1. The meeting was called to order at 5:04 pm by Susie Kimble

- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- 3. The mission statement was read by Susie Kimble.
- 4. Public Input: There was none.
- 5. Moved by Fernando Macias and seconded by Martha Valdez that the agenda be adopted. Votes: Unanimous.
- 6. Moved by Martha Valdez and seconded Fernando Macias that the minutes of December 17, 2020 be approved. Votes: Unanimous.
- 7. Kyle Hunt presented the financial reports for the school covering the period up to 12/31/20. These reports were accepted by the council unanimously. BAR #0015 was presented to the council for review and approval (after discussion that discussion and action on item C was enough for the council to be able to vote. This discussion included the broadness of item C while also having to meet the PED deadline of 1/31/20 to accept these funds in OBMS.) The BAR is for the Governor's Emergency Economic Relief (GEERs) Fund in the amount of \$3,474 which would help the school cover student connectivity costs incurred from the result of the pandemic. Moved by Fernando Macias and Seconded by Martha Valdez that BAR #0015 be accepted. Votes: unanimous.
- 8. Lobbyist Contract: Moved by Fernando Macias and seconded by Martha Valdez that the contract be accepted. Votes: Unanimous.
- 9. Discussion was had regarding a policy to require Covid vaccinations for all employees. The action item was tabled until February when more guidance was provided by the Governor and the attorneys.
- 10. Superintendent report:
  - Preliminary report for sy19-20 from CSD was presented. 12 out of 21 areas were "meets standards." NAS will submit all other requested evidence to meet standard in preparation for renewal.
  - We currently have 204 students enrolled.
  - School Safety Plan was submitted.
  - Dr. Martin Luther King Service Day was on Monday. We had students participate. We had different options for activities to choose from but all were tied to a writing assignment.
  - Daycare is moving toward completion. Right now, our urgency is to purchase and set up the room in order to call for other inspections, such as fire.
  - Capital Outlay: \$20K was requested for computers, \$20K for bathroom remodel, and \$20k for furniture
