- ELTP/K-12 Plus: NAS-LC will apply for the ELTP which is an additional 8 days. It has generated \$95K for the program. The other grant is the K-12 Planning grant. This is for \$25,000 to plan in the next year how to develop a different plan for the extended learning plan.
- Marketing plan: we are advertising in the Bulletin for the next 13 weeks. The billboards continue. Other recommendations?
- Ballet Folklorico: Talks continue to happen with LADH to begin the feeder program. One student has committed to register here. We are planning to use some Capital Outlay money to equip a room with mirrors and a moveable floor.
