## **Superintendent's Report**

- 80 -day count: 146 This is a decrease from 170 in October.
- "Under monitoring Status" for 22-23. This is due to the attendance rate during assessments. We are required to create an action plan. NAS does not need to formally submit a plan, but have one in place at the local level. On February 10, we will have parent/teacher conferences and will ask parents for input.
- Roof work: The warranty that was purchased by FYI did come out to make some roof repairs. The diagnostics that were completed last month looked good. We can purchase an additional roof care.
- Senior Day: Jan. 6, Job Corp, Scholar Dollar application, FASFA and shirt printing.
- Fun Friday: Jan. 27<sup>th</sup>
- Homeless money awarded from ARP: \$9,937. This will be allocated to our homeless liaison to purchase clothing and food for our students. We currently have 13 identified.
